

Proposed Amendment – Section 48-A

CURRENT BY-LAW

Section 48-A. The Lake level must be lowered in October in each even year. Association members may request the lowering of the lake on alternate years subject to the approval of the Board of Governors.

PROPOSED CHANGES – Substantial Change

Section 48-A. ~~The Lake level must be lowered in October in each even year.~~ The Lake level may be lowered in each even year for a period of no more than sixteen days. The start of the drawdown will be determined at the September Board of Governors meeting. The lake will be drawn down to the maximum level of the desired depth as indicated on the lake gauge at the spillway. The sixteen-day period of the draw down will start once the lake has reached the desired depth. The lowering of the lake is to give Association members time to install or repair docks, cleanup shoreline debris and to reclaim sand at our beaches.

The Board of Governors may vote to lower the lake for emergency at any time for weather related issues, such as flooding, spillway repair or major lake issues. Association members may request the lowering of the lake on alternate years subject to the approval of the Board of Governors.
