

Proposed Amendment – Section 41 & 41-A

CURRENT BY-LAW

LAKE PRIVILEGE

Section 41. Property owners, their relatives, and visiting friends are entitled to the use of the entire lake surface for their recreation of rowing, sailing, fishing and bathing, but do these at their own risk. This association assumes no liability over persons on the lake surface beyond their peaceful conduct. There will be surveillance over the fishing privileges to enforce the State Fish and Game Laws, and such rules relative to fishing as provided in its by-laws.

Section 41-A. The propelling of boats or other recreational vehicles (year-round) on Hidden Lake by a gasoline engine, Diesel engine, a steam engine, an alcohol engine, a kerosene engine, whether of portable type or built in, is prohibited. The use of electric trolling motors is permitted, with a maximum of 55 lb. thrust and the battery accompanying the electric motor must be a sealed cell system. This shall not prohibit the use by the Association of any power engine in a utility boat or a police boat. (Amended Nov. 2018)

PROPOSED CHANGE

Section 41. This association assumes no liability over persons on the lake surface beyond their peaceful conduct. There will be surveillance over the fishing privileges to enforce the State Fish and Game Laws, and such rules relative to fishing as provided in its by-laws.

Section 41-A. The propelling of boats or other recreational vehicles (year-round) on Hidden Lake by a gasoline engine, Diesel engine, a steam engine, an alcohol engine, a kerosene engine, whether of portable type or built in, is prohibited. The use of electric trolling motors is permitted, with a maximum of 55 lb. thrust and the battery accompanying the electric motor must be a sealed cell system.
